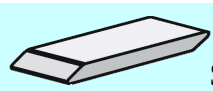


Counting Change

When you buy an item, you might not have the exact coins and notes for the amount it costs. However, you can pay with a larger note, and get back some change.

To give change, or to check the change you are given, count up from *the price* of the item until you reach the amount the the customer gave.

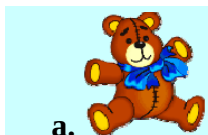

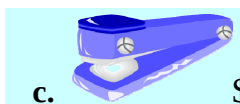
