



Topic: Place Value.

Object: Develop a deeper understanding of place value for two-digit numbers and explore three-digit numbers.

<u>2</u>			405
<u>*</u>	Write the missing number.		
<u>3</u>	3 hundreds + 2 tens = 320	<u>4</u>	5 hundreds + 2 tens + 0 ones = 520
<u>5</u>	1 hundreds + 2 tens + 3 ones = 123	<u>6</u>	9 hundreds + 5 ones = 905
<u>7</u>	3 hundreds + 2 tens + 9ones = 329	<u>8</u>	3 hundreds + 10 tens = 400
<u>9</u>	4 hundreds + 10 ones = 410	<u>10</u>	6 hundreds + 6 tens + 6 ones = 666
<u>11</u>	60 tens = 6 hundreds	<u>12</u>	3 hundreds = 30 tens = 300 ones
